Petition Drive Exceeds Goal

Minimum # of signatures needed = 370Goal (minimum needed + 15% extra) = 425

Final number of signatures collected = 456

(456 represents 23.4% of all F.B. registered voters)

What Happens Next?

- **1.** Oct 11th Petition will be presented to Council
- 2. Signatures are validated
- **3. City Council considers Petition**

Petition Timeline (Best Guess)

Oct 11th - Petition presented to City Council

Oct - Nov? - Signatures are validated

Dec - Jan ? - Council receives Petition Request

Why will it take so long?

It may take longer than expected for the Charleston County Election Commission to validate the signatures because the November election has a higher priority than our Petition.

Project Goals

- Test different Noise Monitoring Systems for one year
- Determine pros and cons of each system
- Install equipment in STRs, private homes & condos
- Bring test sites on line by April 2023

History of Folly Beach Mandatory Noise Monitoring

- Jan 2022 Recommended by City's STR Committee
- May 2022 Included in Ordinance 27-22 by Mayor
- June 2022 Removed from Ordinance 27-22 by council opposition
- Sept 2022 Ordinance 27-22 passed without mandatory noise monitoring
- Next Year We'll encourage the Council to reconsider adopting mandatory noise monitoring
